CORONA VIRUS EFFECT: SENSEX FALLS 1448 POINTS

Benchmark Sensex which was going strong since the beginning of this year has today fallen victim to the coronavirus outbreak across the world. Other factors like high rate of inflation, falling of economic growth and weak GDP growth are also cracking the market down.

Sensex closed 1448 points lower at 38297 and Nifty lost 431 points to 11,201 today. This was the second-biggest fall for the Sensex ever (in terms of points) in a single day. Highest fall ever was recorded when Sensex plunged 1624 points to close at 25741 on August 24, 2015. While Sensex has clocked 7.17% fall since the beginning of this year, Nifty has fallen 7.94% during the period. On the contrary, things were very rosy five months ago.
